CV Doris Lindner

The young Austrian concert pianist Doris Lindner studied piano at the Anton Bruckner Privatuniversität in Linz with Till A. Körber, and also at the Vienna University of Music and Performing Arts. She graduated with distinction in piano, chamber music, and recorder teaching and performance. She won an Erasmus scholarship for the Royal Northern College of Music in Manchester, where she studied with Peter Lawson. Doris has given recitals throughout Austria, Germany, Switzerland, Spain, Romania, England, Greece, Iceland and Taiwan. She has appeared as a soloist with many orchestras and was invited by the International Youth Orchestra BISYOC to perform Liszt's Piano Concerto No.2 at the famous Haydnsaal in Schloss Esterhazy. Doris Lindner has participated in numerous master classes with many eminent musicians including György Kurtág, Bruno Canino, Ferenc Rados, Norma Fisher and Elisabeth Leonskaja.

She is the recipient of several prizes in both national and international competitions.

She took the first prize in the International Carl Filtsch Competition in Sibiu in 2006, won the YAMAHA-Stipendium-Austria and was awarded the Peter Donohoe Prize for her playing in 2007. In 2008 she became a laureate of Yehudi Menuhin's Live Music Now foundation.

Doris is leading a piano and recorder class in a music school in Lower Austria, she also did the accompaniment for the "Musik-Akademie-Oberschützen.

As one of the most talented young artists she was selected for the "Ö1 Talentebörse" (Austrian Radio Cultural Award Programme) which led to CD productions and broadcasting on the National radio stations of Austria and Iceland. For one year Doris toured with the london recorder quartet "iFlautisti" through the UK and was invited for broadcasting on BBC 3.

She is giving recitals as a soloist as well as a chamber musician. With the trio frizzante Doris is performing within the New Austrian Sounds of Music program supported by the Austrian cultural foreign ministry. Their upcoming concerts will lead them to Iran, Poland, South-Africa and the Americas.
